ACCEPTED STUDENT Checklist

Sign up for and request a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID). Access the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at <i>www.fafsa.ed.gov</i> in order to e-sign or renew your FAFSA. The FAFSA is available after October 1.
Complete the FAFSA on the Web at <i>www.fafsa.ed.gov</i> and use the Penn State code: 003329. Submit by February 15 for maximum student aid consideration.
Review your Financial Aid Award Notification . The Office of Student Aid begins to email students in late March. You can also view your financial aid award online in the LionPath system (<i>lionpath.psu.edu</i>).
Accept your offer of admission. Sign in to your "My Penn State" account to accept your offer before Penn State's preferred deadline of May 1.
Activate your Access Account. Check your email often. Penn State Identity Services will send time- sensitive account activation instructions (the link expires in 7 days).
Take the ALEKS Math Placement Test . Go online to <i>orientation.psu.edu/testing</i> for more information.
Sign up for New Student Orientation (NSO) Day 1 for advising and scheduling after you have completed the ALEKS placement test. Go to <i>newkensington.psu.edu/nso</i> for more information.
View your tuition bill (eBill) in LionPath. Fall semester bills are usually available starting in mid-July. To view your bill, visit <i>lionpath.psu.edu.</i>
Attend NSO Days 2&3 (mandatory) before classes begin. (This is for students only and occurs the week before classes begin in August.) Go to <i>newkensington.psu.edu/nso</i> for more information.
Fall Semester begins August 21. Important semester dates can be found at <i>registrar.psu.edu</i> .
