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WHAT IS ORIENTATION?





3 Days To Success ...

Orientation is a three-day process that includes NSO (Academic Advising day) and New Student Days (often referred to as Pride Day and All Prides day). All three days are designed to educate, encourage and inspire you as you embark on your academic journey. Our main objective is to provide you with the necessary tools to facilitate a smooth transition into college life, but also to assist you in exploring varied opportunities as you prepare for your future. A description of Penn State New Kensington (PSNK) orientation days is below.

NSO—Academic Advising Day (DAY 1)

June— August (Must register online and choose your day!)

Based on placement test scores, career objectives, and academic advisor recommendations, your appropriate courses will be assigned. In addition to developing a schedule, you will receive important information on campus resources.

New Student Days—August 15th and 16th (8:30 a.m.—4:30 p.m.)

At Day 2 (Pride Day), you will attend interactive workshops conducted by faculty and staff, and participate in a discussion on our summer <u>reading book</u>: Callings. We will introduce you to our campus tradition, Orientation Prides, led by our student Orientation Leaders. Orientation Leaders will guide your Pride through fun activities and show off their acting skills in a series of theatrical skits!

During Day 3 (All Prides Day), you will meet many of your fellow classmates and attend college meetings, academic convocation, and be formally welcomed to Penn State. Near the end of Day 3, you will interact with faculty and staff at the campus picnic and take part in the Penn State New Kensington traditional rainbow picture and "Pride Olympics". Prides will compete with one another in various activities — teamwork, communication, and creativity will be the key to your victory!

<u>Orientation Prides:</u> A PRIDE is a company of lions bonding together in support of each other. At Orientation 2018, you will become part of a Penn State campus tradition!

NOTE: All 3 days of orientation are <u>mandatory</u> for all new students. Mark the dates on your calendars! Parents, Guardians and Guests are welcome to attend. Registration for Days 2 & 3 is automatic when you register and confirm your registration for New Student Orientation Day 1—Academic Advising.

Coming August 9th... Avengers: Infinity War!




Summer To-Do Checklist:
